Newmarket's first fully accessible Spray Pad, located at Margaret Arkinstall Park, opened in August 2021. The water park includes a soft water play surface, spray, shade sails, site furniture, connecting pathways, and a picnic area surrounded by soft landscaping.

New Stop Signs: Peter Hall Drive & Sawmill Valley Drive; McCaffrey Road & Rannie Road

Speed Limit Reductions: Mulock Drive reduction to 60km/h; Jordanray Boulevard reduction to 20km/h

Traffic Light Installed: Clearmeadow Boulevard and Bathurst Street

Traffic Calming Bollards: Joe Persechini Drive; Doubletree Lane

Solar Mounted Speed Boards: 14 Boards (up from 7)
